2. Tools

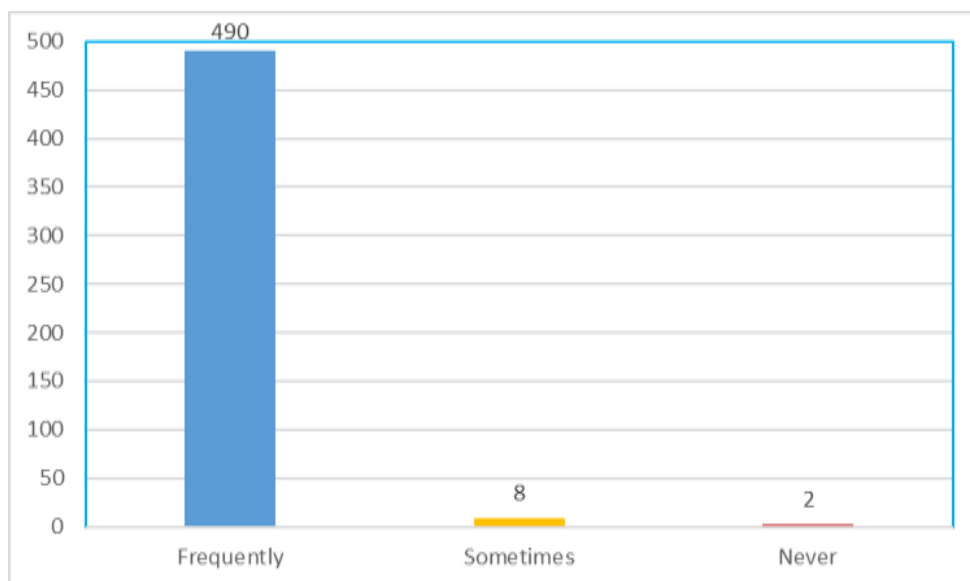
Researcher has used self-made questionnaire which has been validated by experts.

6. My Parents force me to go to various coaching classes.

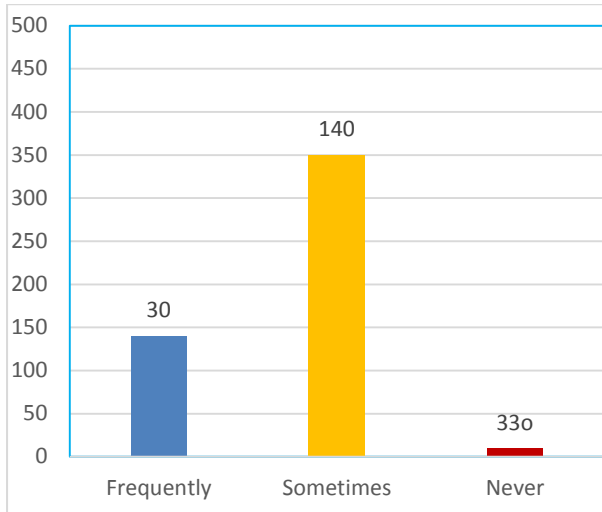

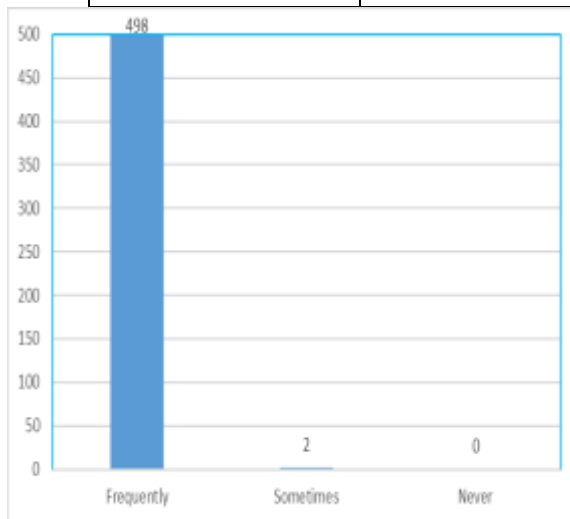

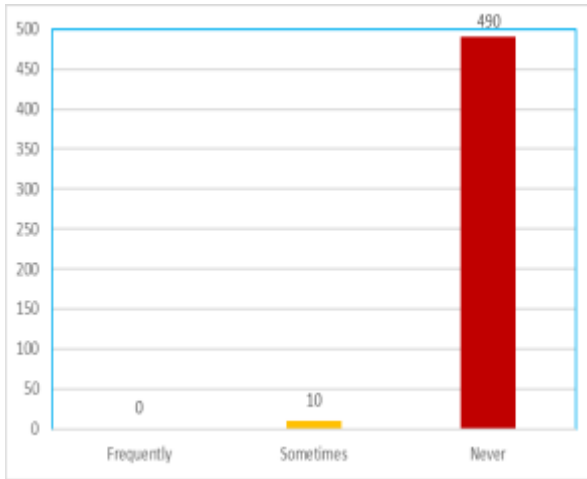

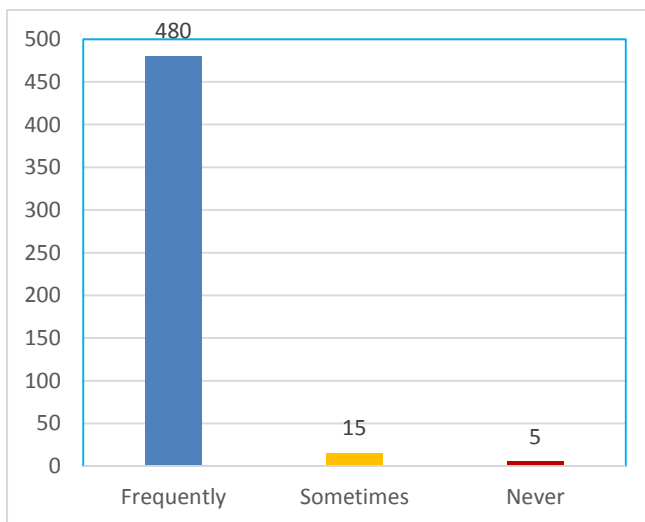

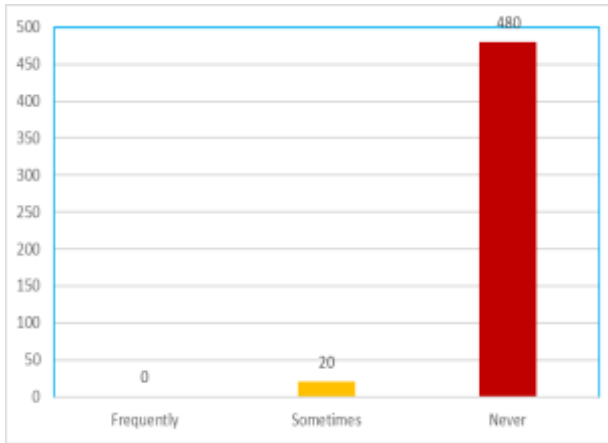

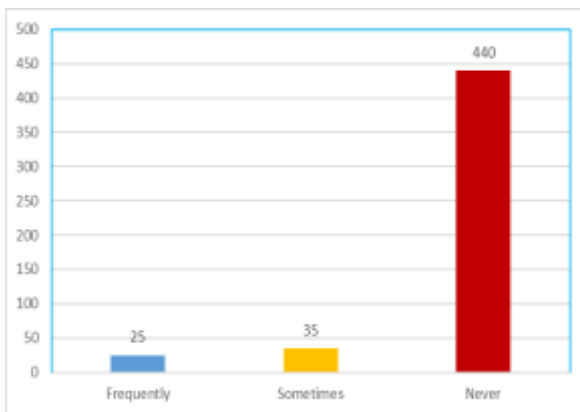
